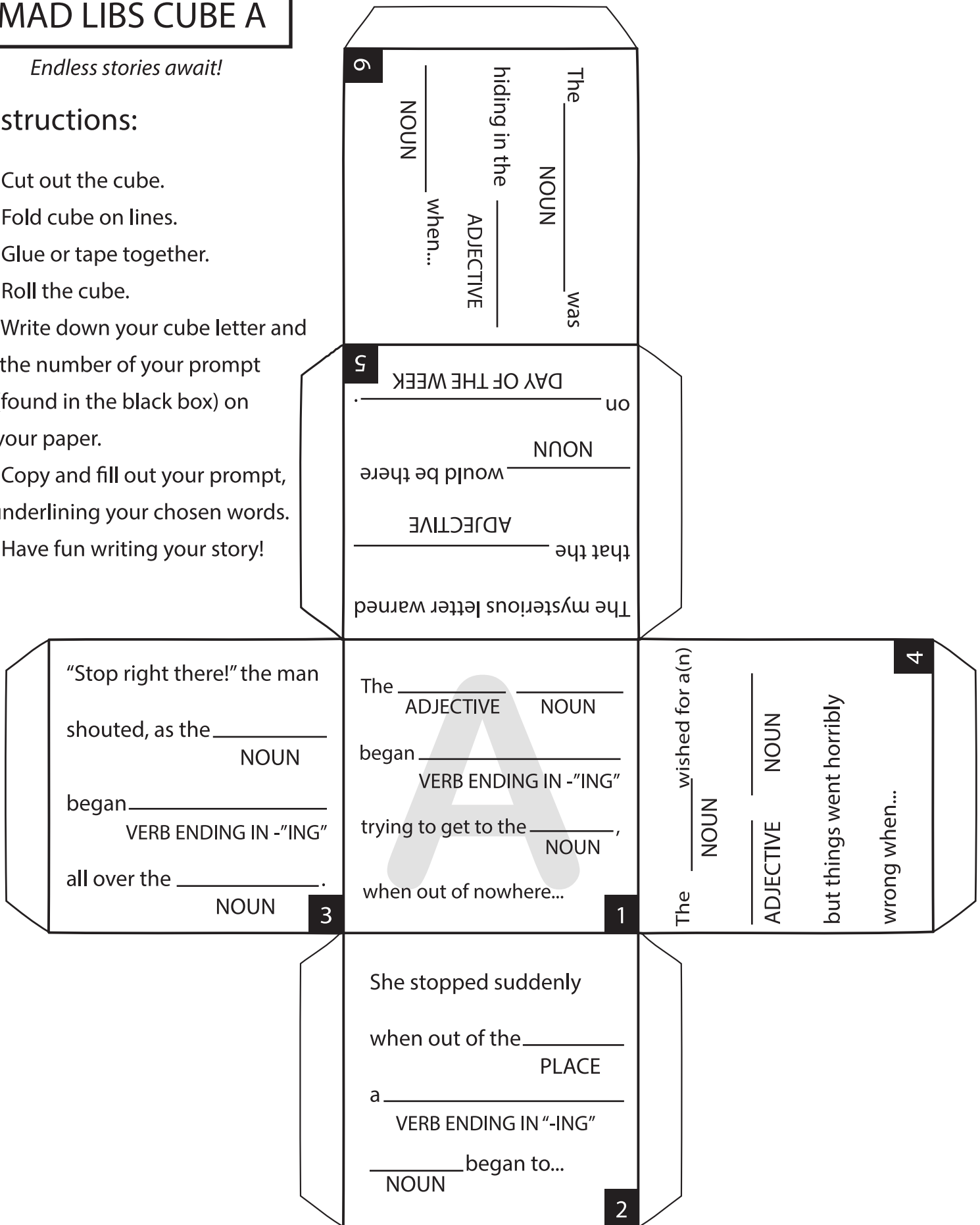


MAD LIBS CUBE A

7. Have fun writing your story!

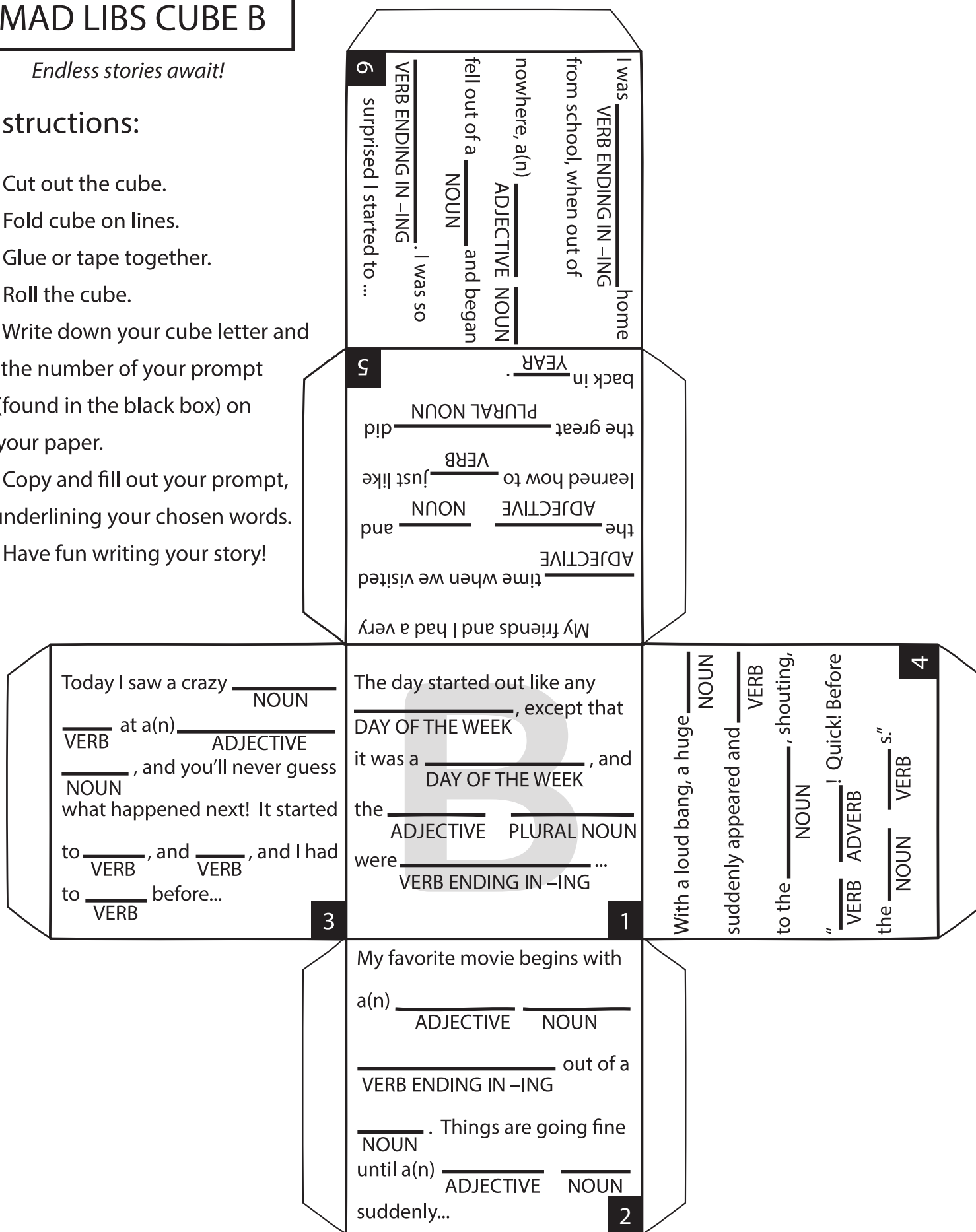

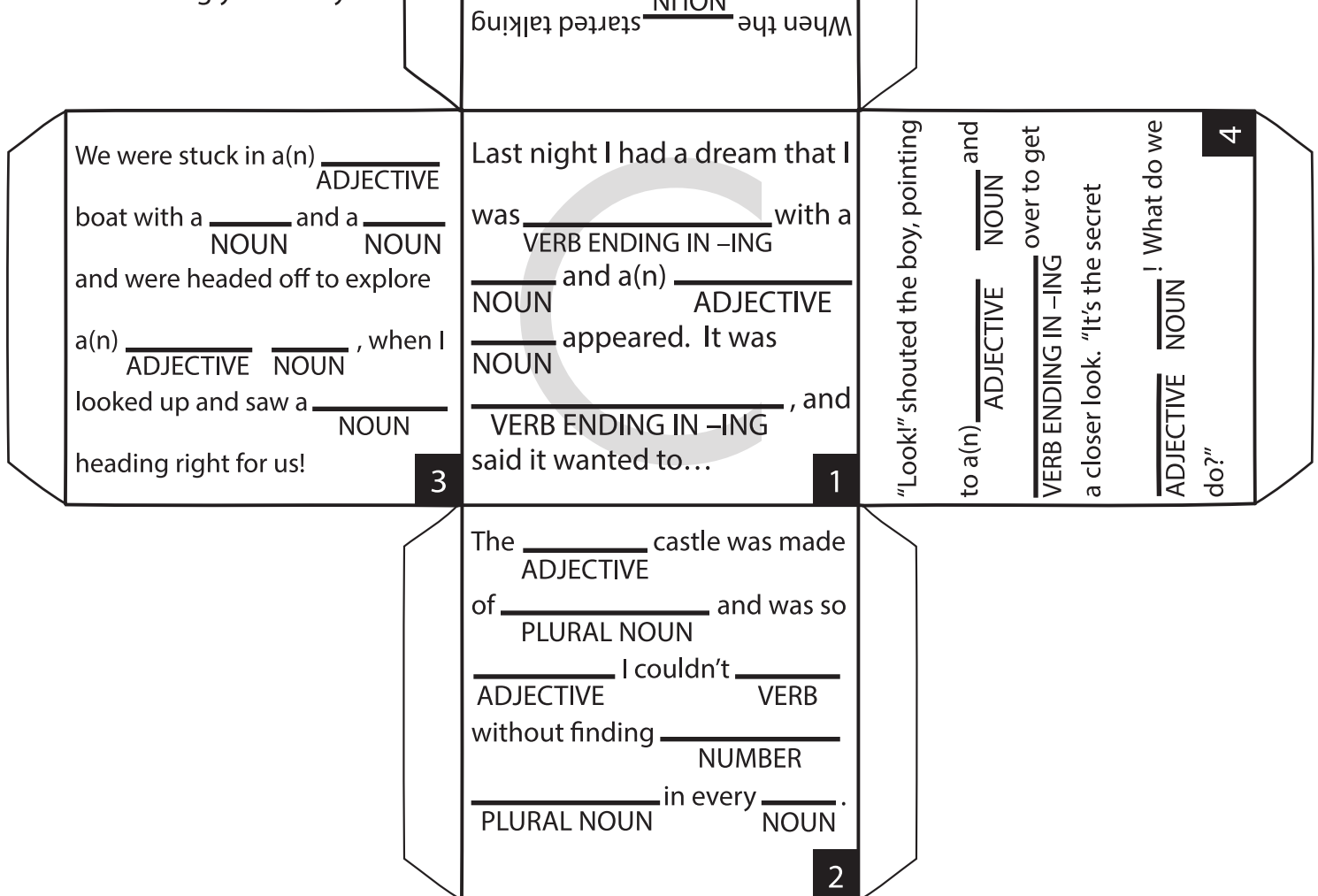
