Upper Elementary

This week we will review infinitive verbs.

- Get started by visiting the “verbs infinitive” section on the [Digital Dialects website](#).
- Click the headphones next to each verb and listen to how the verb is pronounced at least 2 or 3 times. In this exercise, you are going to review the verbs that you have already learned and learn some new verbs.
- Reinforce what you have learned by playing the games. Start with the Text Game and then play the Audio Game.
- Download a list of verbs from the page. Read, write, and memorize these verbs.
- Conjugate the verbs you have studied in this lesson using personal pronouns. Then write 10 sentences using the vocabulary you already know.

After this exercise you will know many useful Spanish verbs. I hope you enjoy practicing these verbs.

Lower Elementary

This week we will review food and drink vocabulary verbs.

- Get started by visiting the “food” section on the [Digital Dialects website](#).
- Click on “Learn words.” A picture of an egg will appear. Listen to the Spanish word for egg (huevo). Continue with the next pictures and listen to the Spanish names. Pay attention to how the Spanish words are written and pronounced. Do this exercise 2 or 3 times.
- Reinforce what you have learned by playing the games. Start with the Text Game - read each word and click on the matching picture.
- Next, play the Audio Game - click on the food/drink item that matches the word.
- Finally, use this vocabulary to write 10 sentences. Read these sentences aloud.
